

Camp Packing List

Required Packing List:

An outfit for each day of camp:

- T-Shirts/Modest tank tops (a)
- Pants/Modest shorts (a)
- Closed-Toed shoes and socks (b)
- Undergarments
- Pajamas
- Outerwear (pending weather)

Swimming & Shower Supplies

- Swim suit (c)
- Sandals/flip flops
- Beach Towel
- Bath Towels, wash cloths, etc.
- Soap & Shampoo
- Toothbrush & Toothpaste

Cabin Supplies

- Linens (bedding/sleeping bag, pillow)
- Flashlight
- Laundry Bag

Activity Supplies

- Sunscreen & Bug Spray
- Bible & Writing material
- Medication (as needed) (d)

Registration Items

- Camp store money (\$10-\$20)
- Camper Health History Form
- Cell Phone Form

Optional Packing List:

- Personal basic art/craft materials (drawing paper, markers, gimp, etc)
- Stuffed Animals
- Disposable Cameras
- Camp-specific items (for theme nights, special events, talent shows, etc)
- Instruments
- Water shoes
- Water Bottle
- A Small Bag

What NOT to bring to camp:

- **Electronic games**
- **Weapons of any kind**
- **Phones/Cameras**
- **Pets**
- **Personal food**
- **Tobacco/Drugs/Alcohol of any kind**
- **Personal sports equipment (fishing poles, sports balls, goggles)**
- **Car Keys (g)**

- (a) Clothing must not have inappropriate language, excessive rips or tears, and they must not be too revealing. Shirts must cover the entire midriff and shorts must cover the upper thighs.
 - (b) Closed-Toes shoes must attach securely to the back of the heel and cover the campers toes. They must be able to stay on securely when participating in highly active activities.
 - (c) Swim suits must be modest. Boys trunks must cover the upper thighs, and girls suits must be one piece and adequately cover the midriff area.
 - (d) Medication will be collected at registration and will be administered at the necessary times by the camp nurse. If the campers needs medication for an emergency anaphylactic situation, the counselor will have the medication on their person at all times in case it is needed
 - (e) All campers will receive a water bottle at registration to use for the week
 - (f) Money will be collected at registration. Campers won't personal money with them during camp
 - (g) If a camper drives themselves to camp, their keys must be kept in the camp office
